

#### **Terms of Reference**

- Review of international best practices handling congestion, market surveillance and governance, market-based instruments etc.
- Technical assistance for regional energy market development including the power exchange based trade.
- To identify country specific policies, regulations and other aspects for Implementation of Power Exchange based trade in South Asia.
- Review for the required market structure in the SA region for a trading mechanism for renewable energy, ancillary services & spinning reserves etc.

- Developing a strategy paper for creation of SAREM
- Expand the Task Force-3 to South East Asian region (BIMSTEC).
- Analysis of existing commercial arrangements for power trade in South Asia.


