The main sessions of the South Asian Clean Energy Forum (SACEF) 2023 are set to begin tomorrow, Wednesday, May 3, commencing with the Opening Session entitled 'Shaping the Future of Energy in South Asia: Partnerships, Technologies, and Opportunities.' This significant event will be graced by the presence of senior officials from the host country, India, alongside Ms. Veena Reddy, Mission Director, USAID/India, and Ms. Patricia A. Lacina, Chargé d'Affaires, US Embassy in India. Their participation highlights the importance of collaboration among key stakeholders in addressing the energy challenges facing the region.

The inaugural theme, underscores the necessity of cooperation to accelerate the deployment of advanced clean energy solutions, modernize utilities, and innovate green financing solutions. SACEF 2023 is designed as a platform to facilitate knowledge exchange, establish partnerships, and foster collaborations that propel the energy sector forward in the region. The forum comprises 8 main sessions structured around three thematic pillars: technology and innovation, policy and regulation, and financing and investment.
