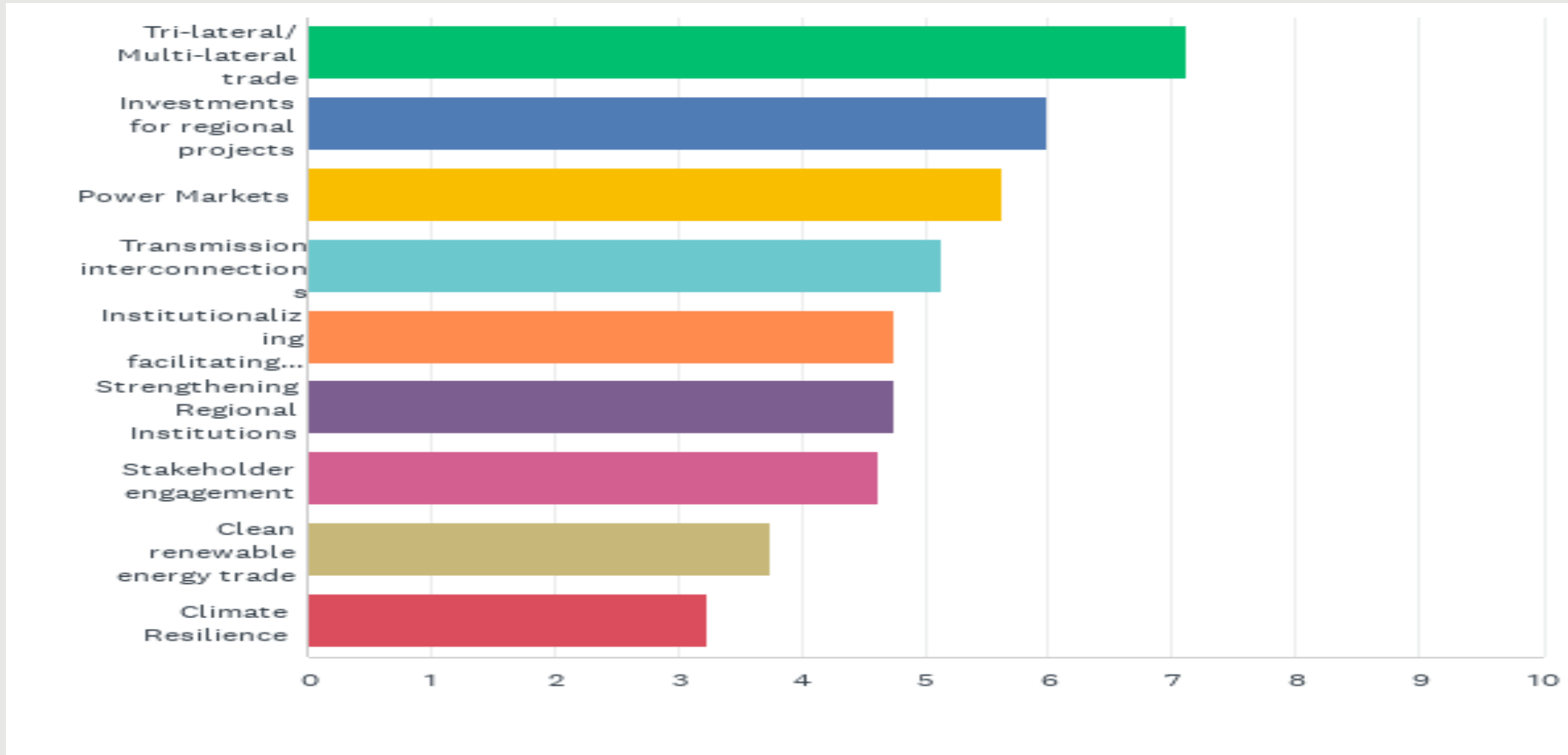

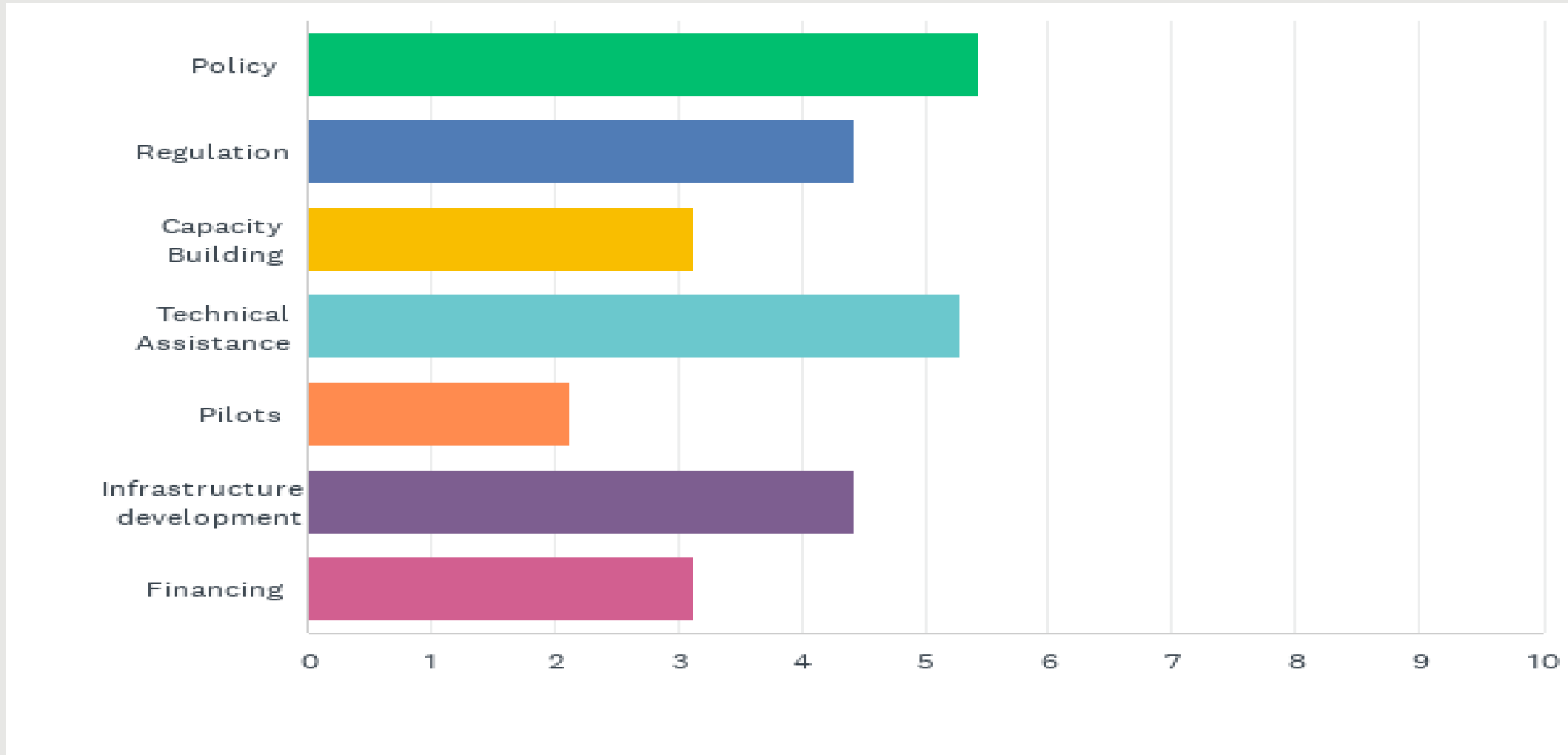
Q1: Rank the following sub-themes in order of priority for the working group to focus on (rank 1 is the highest and rank 9 is the lowest):
